It's the science that says it: Bella Hadid is the most beautiful

A renowned cosmetic surgeon, Dr. Julian De Silva has unveiled the list of 10 women whose faces, according to science, borders on perfection. Physical. To reach this ranking (relayed by the [Daily Mail](#)), he analyzed nine portions of the face of several celebrities (face shape, forehead, nose, philtrum - located between the base of the nose and the upper lip -, eyebrow, eyebrows, lips, chin, position of the eyes) and applied an equation coming from the ancient Greeks, based on the Phi number - or golden number (approximately 1,618). The closer we get to this ratio, the better we are.

In theory, to get closer to perfection, a woman should therefore have: Beyoncé's face shape, [Bella's](#) forehead and chin, Amber's nose, philtrum and eyebrows, lips and face. Cara's eyebrow arch, the position of [Scarlett's](#) eyes.
