According to calculations made by plastic surgeon Julian De Silva , [Robert Pattinson](#) is the most beautiful man in the world. The 33-year-old actor showed himself to be 92.15% symmetrical from the Golden Ratio, a measure created in Ancient Greece.

The analysis was done using computerized facial mapping techniques, listing the ten most "beautiful" celebrities.

"The Golden Ratio is a mathematical equation created by the Greeks in an attempt to measure beauty, and can be applied to anything. It was used by Leonardo Da Vinci for the perfect human male body in his famous work, 'Vitruvian Man'. The premise is that the closer the proportions of a face or body to the number 1.618 (Phi), the more beautiful people are, " [explained Julian De Silva on Instagram](#) .

"These new computer mapping techniques allow us to solve some of the mysteries of what makes someone physically beautiful, and the technology is useful in planning patients' surgery," he concluded.
